ELIGIBILITY

1. This competition is open to female artists from Indiana, Kentucky, and Illinois who are 18 years or older.
2. **NEW POLICY** - As of 2010, Arts Council membership is **required**, to enter the exhibition (see registration form for fee information.)
3. All submitted art **MUST** have been completed within the last 2 years (nothing prior to 2008) and **CANNOT** have won a cash award in any previous exhibition or displayed in an Arts Council juried exhibition.
4. Accepted art **MUST** remain on display for the entire duration of the show.

EXHIBITION RULES

- ♦ All media are eligible**
- ♦ ****The Women's Hospital requests that works of art depicting explicit sexual acts or violent subject matter **NOT** be submitted.**
- ♦ Any artwork that does not meet the exhibition requirements **WILL NOT** be accepted.
- ♦ All artists will be notified about their entry status (accepted or not) via E-MAIL on Monday, April 16 by 2p.m.(CST). If you **DO NOT** receive your e-mail by 3p.m. (CST), please call the Arts Council at 812-422-2111
- ♦ Displayed artwork **MUST BE** retrieved on Friday, June 18 from the Women's Hospital 3rd floor atrium between 3-6p.m. (CST). Any artwork remaining will automatically become the property of the Arts Council of Southwestern Indiana.

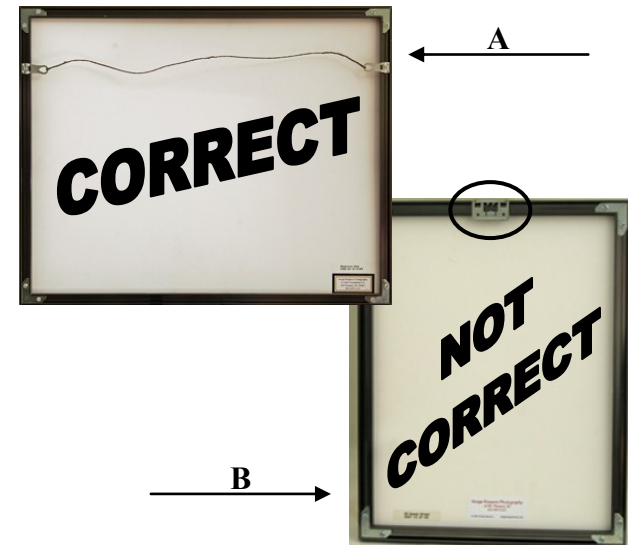
MEDIA SPECIFICATIONS

2D ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- ♦ overall **FRAMED** dimensions, cannot exceed **48" x 60"**
- ♦ submissions **MUST BE** appropriately framed and securely wired (**A**), using proper hardware (most entries will hang on art panels or walls)
- ♦ entries using saw-tooth hangers (**B**) or other hanging apparatus **WILL NOT be accepted**

3D ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- ♦ Overall dimensions should not exceed 2' x 3' x 6'h
- ♦ piece should not weigh more than what can be safely and securely lifted by one person (pieces **WILL BE MOVED** to art display area from jury room)



All sales generated from **INSPIRED WOMEN IN ART** will be subject to the **35% commission policy, established by the Arts Council**. Each artist should price their work accordingly, if the piece is for sale. If not for sale, mark the piece NFS.

JUROR

Laura Foster Nicholson, currently residing in New Harmony, Indiana, is a textile artist known for hand-woven brocaded tapestries. Educated at Kansas City Art Institute (BFA) and Cranbrook Academy of Art (MFA), she has lectured, taught classes & workshops, and exhibited extensively in the US, Canada and Italy. Grants and awards include an NEA fellowship, the Leone di Pietra prize at the 1985 Venice Biennale of Architecture, three Illinois Arts Council fellowships, and a grant from the Graham Foundation for Research in the Fine Arts.

She owns LFNTextiles, which designs jacquard ribbon, custom upholstery and drapery fabrics. She has licensed designs to Crate & Barrel, Land of Nod, Grow Kids, Renaissance Ribbons, and Larsen, Inc. for production.

Laura has served as a juror on many occasions throughout her professional career, including the St. Louis Art Fair in 1996 and the 2008 Art & Soul exhibit at the New Harmony Gallery. She served on the Industry Advisory Board at Savannah College of Art & Design, 2006-2008 and the Scholarship review committee for the Handweaver's Guild of America, 1997-2009. She is the founding chair for New Harmony's annual art fair, Arts in Harmony. Laura was listed in the 1986 edition of Who's Who in American Art.

Laura Foster Nicholson's tapestries are found in the collections of: The Art Institute of Chicago, Cooper Hewitt National Design Museum, The Archives of the Venice Biennale, The Minneapolis Institute of Arts, The Denver Art Museum, The Racine Art Museum, The Reading Public Museum, Cranbrook Academy of Art Museum, and many private and corporate art collections nationwide.
